**1. ASTI MARTINI SPUMANTE**

**£14.95**

*This popular Italian sparkling wine is aromatic and fruity with a sweeter finish. The ideal aperitif or celebration wine.*

**2. VEUVE CHAPELLE NV BRUT.**

**£17.50**

*A fine sparkling wine from France with a crisp finish.*

**3. LANSON BLACK LABEL NV BRUT.**

**£37.50**

*This elegant champagne has a delicate nose with a full taste and a smooth, lingering finish.*

**4. POL ROGER NV BRUT**

**5. SAUVIGNON TOURAINE 2010**

**£16.95**

*From the beautiful Loire Valley region, this is an aromatic, dry wine produced from quality Sauvignon Blanc grapes. This classic French white has crisp gooseberry flavours with a clean zesty finish*

**6. CHABLIS LA COLOMBE 2010**

**£24.95**

*This famous dry wine is made from the finest Chardonnay grapes from the renowned Burgundy region in Central France. Dry and steely with a lively crisp mineral finish.*

### **PRIORY CHARDONNAY 2011**

*Refreshing unoaked dry white from the Curico Valley.*

### **8. DIAMOND BAY CHENIN BLANC 2010**

### **9. MIRABELLO PINOT GRIGIO 2011**

*The very fashionable Pinot Grigio grape produces a fresh elegant, easy drinking dry wine. From Veneto in North East Italy, this is a crisp and refreshing aromatic dry white wine, which suits most taste buds.*

### **10. MOKO BLACK SAUVIGNON BLANC. 2011**

**£19.95**

*From the world-renowned vineyards of Marlborough comes this fresh tasting zesty medium dry white wine. Made from selected Sauvignon grapes, this is rich and full of tropical flavours. A superb wine with intense fruit flavours in the lingering finish.*

### **11. COTES DU RHONE 2010**

**£15.95**

*A classic red from the Rhone Valley in Southern France, this is a fruity blend of Grenache and Syrah grapes which flourish in this part of the world.*

### **12. BEAU CHENE PINOT NOIR 2009**

**£17.95**

*Soft red fruit flavours are evident in this Pinot Noir from Southern France, where the warming Mediterranean sun ripens the grapes to perfection.*

### **13. CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE 2009**

**£29.95**

*This world famous rich red from the Rhone Valley is a heavyweight blend of Grenache and Syrah grapes. Delicious!*

## **SPAIN**

### **14. PUERTA VIEJA CRIANZA RIOJA 2008**

**£19.95**

*This excellent red wine is made from the finest Tempranillo grapes, selected from the highest vineyards in the famous Rioja region. Careful oak ageing, followed by further bottle maturation brings the wine to fruition, resulting in warming vanilla tones and a soft spicy finish.*

### **15. PRIORY MERLOT 2011**

**£12.95**

*From the prolific Central Valley region, this has an easy drinking style that suits most palates. Full of berry flavours the Merlot grape has a soft, smooth finish.*

## **ARGENTINA**

**16. MICHEL TORINO MALBEC 2010**

**£16.95**

*This rich and smooth wine sums up the Argentinean wine industry perfectly. Famous for the Malbec grape which produces soft easy drinking wine with good body and a fine rich finish.*

**17. PAARL HEIGHTS SHIRAZ 2011**
